Assignment	Scout Assigned	Duties
All Patrol Members		Pitch dining fly, tents, & prepare other common areas: all patrol activities. 1st: set-up patrol common equipment: Food Boxes, Stoves, & Lanterns. 2 nd : set-up tents, other patrol equipment. Everyone helps until jobs complete & camp secure. Check patrol duty roster for assignment of individual tasks. Divide duties evenly. On long campouts, change assignments after lunch each day. For weekend outings rotate after each meal. For overnight outings, each Scout performs one duty, changing assignments for next campout.
(Acting) Senior Patrol Leader		Runs Camping Trip. Runs Flag ceremonies. Assigns camping troop duties like campfire program owner. Assists Patrol Leaders.
(Acting) Patrol Leader		Runs Patrol. Assigns patrol duties. Assists scouts setting up camp. Oversees advancement programs for patrol members
(Acting) Assistant Patrol Leader		Assists Patrol Leader. Takes charge of Patrol while PL is absent.
(Acting) Patrol Quartermaster		Inspects tents before & after the trip. Assigns scouts to take home tents for cleaning and drying. Buys & Delivers food to Patrol Cooks. Inspects & obtains equipment from Troop Quartermaster.
Main Cook		Assembles food supplies/follows menus/recipes exactly to serve meals on time; stores food, soaks cook pots, & has cleanup water heating before serving meals.
Assistant Cook		Assists Main Cook. See Main Cook Duties.
Fireman		Prepares stoves for use; lights charcoal briquettes/stoves in time for cooks to have meals ready on schedule. Set-up Campfire/Fire safety items/extinguishes fires.
Waterman		Maintains water supply for cooking/drinking. Set-up Water container for campfires.
Kitchen Clean up		Sets up wash and rinse water, cleans cooking pots/utensils; polices kitchen/dining areas; stores patrol equipment, disposes of garbage and trash.
Assistant Kitchen Clean up		See Kitchen Clean up Duties
